The *I Want to be an Ambassador!* camp is a unique and very dynamic seven-day camp focusing on the vital art and skills of diplomacy. Please note that although only one student will receive the Luminari Award, all completed student applications will be considered by Luminari for acceptance into the 2018 camp, and need-based scholarships will be offered to qualified applicants.
