I Want to be an Ambassador! 2026

Luminari's flagship program that began in 2010, *I Want to be an Ambassador!* is designed to help youths master the art and skills of diplomacy. Directed by Emmy Award winning writer and producer Debbie Casini Klein, the seven-day camp takes place in Pittsburgh and Washington, D.C. Just as an ambassador must display behaviors and attitudes that respectfully represent our country while tackling international challenges, campers will learn to respectfully represent their families, schools and communities, build sustainable working relationships, and work to find common ground, where genuine conversation and sharing can take place. Teen Ambassadors will learn the art and skills of everyday diplomacy from expert instructors, CEOs of companies, ambassadors and career diplomats, and local government officials.

Music Makers! 2026

Music Makers!, now entering its fourth year in 2026, offers teens a five-day deep dive into the music industry from songwriting and production to engineering, recording, distribution, and marketing. Led by Bob McCutcheon, a 30-year veteran and award-winning producer, students collaborate to create and record original music using cutting-edge technology. Along the way, they also explore vintage audio equipment and instruments, gaining a rich understanding of music's evolution and its power to connect and inspire.

Camp Delicious! 2026

Camp Delicious! is a five-day camp that focuses on the *enjoyment of food* by inspiring budding culinary artists and even the most reluctant chef to create delectable dinners. Teens will discover new

flavors, learn new skills and gain confidence to improvise in the kitchen. Students will take field trips, learn where food comes from, how to buy it and how to prepare it. And of course, our camp leadership will gently instill awareness for healthy and nutritional eating habits.

The Luminari Award competition was launched in 2011 and is open to all the school districts in Western Pennsylvania. The goals of the award are to recognize the winning students and to honor the dedicated educators in the schools that help them to succeed.
